Weaving a World Without Violence 2014 will be held June 3-4, 2014 in Troy, New York. Your workshop proposal should include:

- Name, address, email, and phone number for presenter
- Title of proposed workshop
- Length of workshop
- Intended audience for workshop (i.e., which group of professionals)
- Level of workshop (advanced, intermediate, beginner)
- Learning objectives for workshop
- Outline for workshop
- Workshop description/abstract (no more than 200 words please)
- Audiovisual needs
- Resume of presenter
- Compensation required for presentation (NYSCASA has extremely limited resources to pay for speakers)
