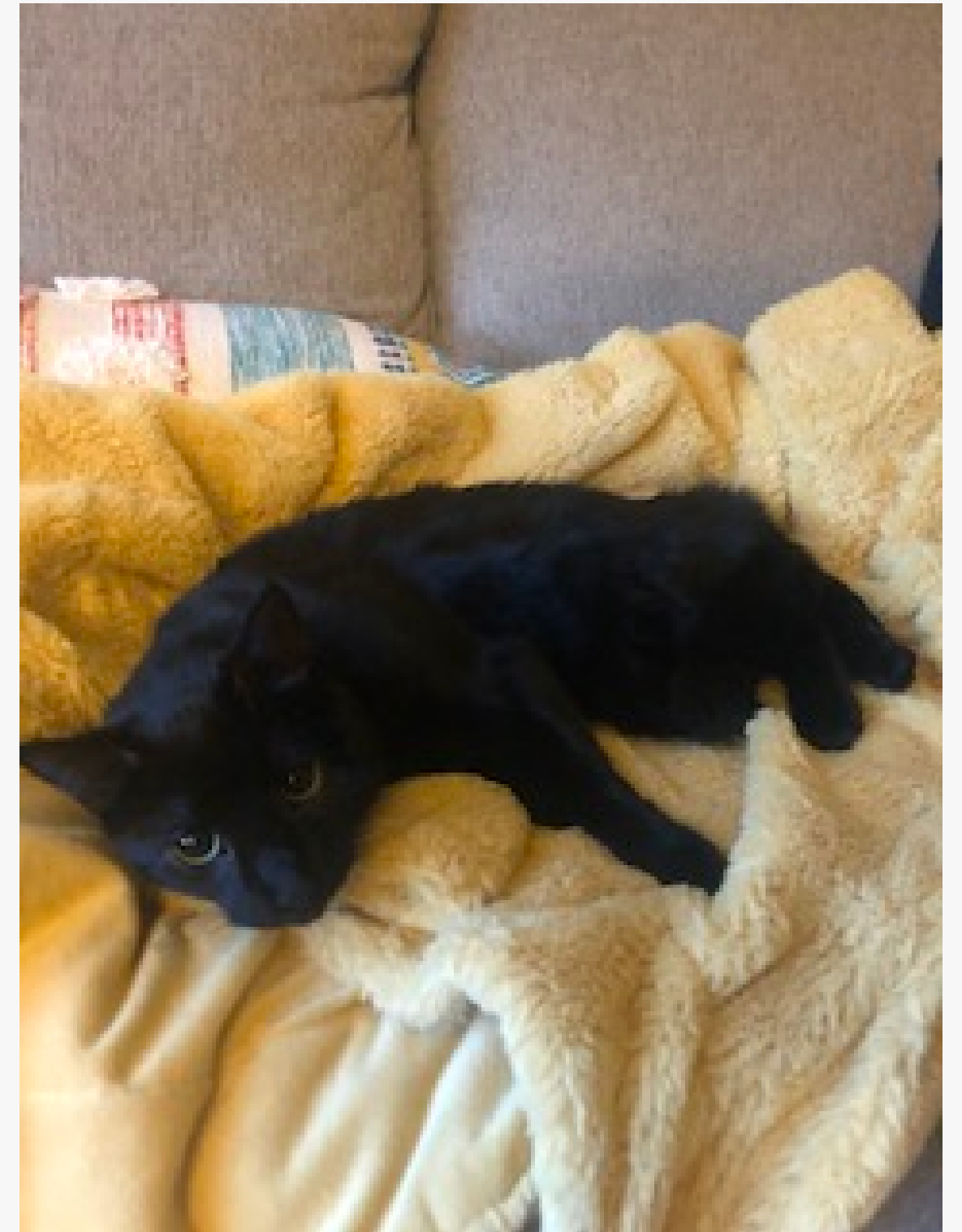

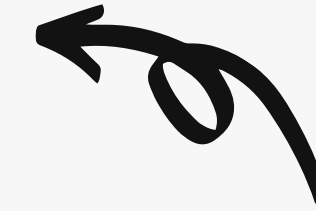

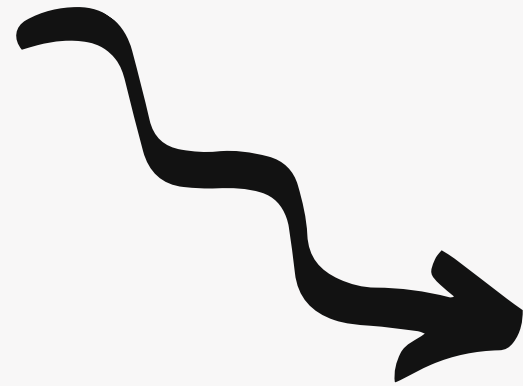


LET'S START HERE!
