  - ~8,500 students enrolled, including RU-Carilion clinic in Roanoke, VA
- SAVES (Substance Abuse & Violence Education Support)
  - Educational programming, advocacy, counseling, crisis intervention...
- My Position: Coordinator of Sexual and Domestic Violence Prevention
  - Primarily responsible for educational programming, peer educator program, outreach

# Background Information

- Currently offer programming as requested
  - Primarily professors requesting programs for their class
  - Athletics also more frequent audience
