Project ECHO: Amplifying Our Work



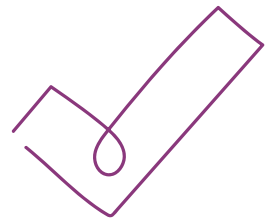
Each section of a Clinic follows the ECHO model, which means that facilitators will ask for participation from those who are on **video** first, **phone** second, and then those who are **in person** last.



Each **case presentation** follows the same order, with an added component. After a case presenter has shared the basics of their case, facilitators ask for a round of **clarifying questions**. After all clarifying questions have been answered, facilitators will ask for **recommendations**. Following this process helps to ensure that participants have the information necessary to make relevant recommendations.



Zoom Tips for Project ECHO



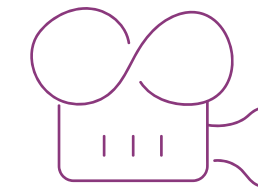
UPDATE YOUR NAME

Hover over your face until you see the ellipsis in the top right. Click it and select 'Rename.' If you're on your phone, you can tap 'Participants,' find your name, tap it, and select 'Rename.'



MUTE YOUR MIC

Please keep your microphone on "mute" while listening. To un-mute yourself, you will click the microphone, which is located on the bottom left side of your screen.



SHARE YOUR VIDEO

Please turn on your video if possible. Kids and pets are welcome on screen!



USE NONVERBAL FEEDBACK

If you'd like to raise your hand or use any of the nonverbal feedback options (e.g., clap your hands, thumbs up, etc.), click on the 'Reactions' button at the bottom of the screen.



CHANGE THE VIEW

We recommend the Gallery View so that you can see each other. You can change your view at the top of your screen on the computer, and by swiping right on your phone.
